Lough Erne Golf Resort opens up one of the most untouched areas of North West Ireland – The Fermanagh Lakelands. At the heart of the region is magnificent Lough Erne, the Jewel in Fermanagh's crown and home to some of Europe's best Fly Fishing. It is a playground for Water Sports including Canoeing, Sailing and Windsurfing; on its shores, Ireland's green countryside waits to be explored with Mountain Climbing, Horse-Riding, Caving at the nearby Marble Arch Caves, Walking, Cycling and Cultural Tours.

With so much to discover, visitors to Lough Erne Golf Resort are spoilt for choice. Here are a few examples of activities to undertake whilst enjoying your stay at The Resort.

FISHING

Fermanagh is a popular destination for experienced fishermen and budding enthusiasts alike...

Patrick Trotter, the resident Ghillie is one of only 140 Master Casting Instructors in the world. He will expertly navigate the waters, sharing the secrets of the Lough and take guests to the best spots for Brown Trout Fly Fishing. Gourmet picnic hampers are provided by acclaimed chef Noel McMeel and 'catch of the day' can be cooked by a personal chef in the privacy and comfort of the Lakeside Lodges. Fly Fishing can be for a ½ day or full day Tour with a choice of locations to include; Castle Hume Lough, Lower Lough Erne, or Local Rivers and Hill Loughs. Also available are casting tuition and game angling courses. The Fly-Fishing season runs from March through to September.

For the more enthusiastic fisherman, Coarse Fishing for Pike, Perch and/or Bream is available for a ½ day or full day Tour with Local Fisherman Brian Reid. Coarse fishing takes place in Lower Lough Erne, Local Rivers and Hill Loughs. Coarse Fishing is available all year round.

WATERSPORTS

Watersports on the fresh, clean waters of the Lough – for those seeking energetic pursuits, The Resort can organise; Windsurfing, Canoeing and Water-Skiing, and Speedboats or Sail Boats for a more relaxing journey, to weave across the tranquil waters between Lower Lough Erne's 365 Islands.

WALKING & CYCLING

Fermanagh is an ideal venue for Walking and Cycling – with its vast array of terrains, mountains, forests and castle walks, there will be something to suit all strengths, abilities and interests.

SEAPLANES AND HELICOPTERS

For an unforgettable bird's eye view, hop aboard a Helicopter from The Resort grounds, Choose from a ½ hr or 1hr Helicopter Tour or a 1 Day Tour to Giants Causeway. Or why not go on a private Seaplane from the Castle Hume Lough jetty.

There is a Choice of ½ hr or 1 hr tour around Donegal/Sligo coasts. Option to include lunch in the 1 hr tour. For those wishing to go further afield, a Scottish Island Tour by Turbo Prop Aircraft can be arranged. Spend the afternoon visiting one of the neighbouring Scottish islands; Islay and the local distillery, just 25 mins flying time from Enniskillen Airport.

HORSERIDING/PONY TREKKING

Some of the best routes in Ireland are available through a BHS approved riding school and trekking centre. Quiet animals to suit beginners, as well as schooled horses for advanced riders are available. Group lessons and Private lessons are also available.

CULTURE & HERITAGE TOURS

The region has a Rich Heritage – and Local Guides including expert Historian and Author John Cunningham, are on hand for Tailor Made Tours. Choose from:

- **Local Sightseeing Tour – Find Fermanagh**
A unique circular tour around Lower Lough Erne through the beautiful Fermanagh Scenery. The highlights include: a Tour of the world famous Belleek Pottery; travel across Boa Island; visit Castle Archdale; see Irelands largest sawmill and the local airport with its Executive jets and Heliport. Also a Tour of the Island town of Enniskillen with its Watergate and Castle.
- **Local Sightseeing Tour – Giants Causeway & Bushmills Distillery**
A Tour through the heartland of Northern Ireland, to the spectacular North Coast, to visit the oldest licensed Whiskey Distiller, Bushmills before visiting the World Heritage Site, The Giants Causeway, where a tale of Finn McCool is told and explore this very rare Basalt column formation.
- **Local Sightseeing Tour – Derry City and Ulster American Folk Park**
Over the centuries conflict, hardship and especially famine have forced millions of people to leave their life in Ireland for the promise of a better life in what is now known as Canada and America. The Folk Park, re-creates the buildings and way of life here and in the new land, at the time when emigration was at its peak. After lunch, spend time exploring the Derry City and take a Walking Tour to discover more history ancient and modern.
- **Heritage and Culture Full Day Local Tour**
Locally around Lower Lough Erne taking in all the above plus the Janus Figure, Pettigo village, Lough Derg, Drumskinney Stone Circle and Ardess Famine Graveyard.
- **Day Trip to Sligo**
Travel to Sligo, taking in Mullaghmore, Lissadell House, Drumcliffe Church and the grave of William Butler Yeats. The shopping in Sligo town and finish at Belleek Pottery.
- **Day Trip to Belfast**
Day tour to Belfast including a City Tour and Shopping. Also visit Queens University, the Republican and Loyalist murals, Stormont House, Belfast City Hall and Belfast Shipyard.
- **Day Trip to Dublin**
Day tours to Dublin or the Boyne Valley including Newgrange Mesolithic Tomb.

DEER STALKING

Deer Stalking at Colebrooke Park – provides access to the full range of deer available in Ireland, Sika, Fallow and Red. Deer Stalking.

It takes place over an area of about 7,000 acres (3,000 hectares), varying from lowland grasslands with small woods to upland heather clad hills with large conifer woods. It is all private to guests and is personally supervised on a daily basis by Lord Brookeborough. Deer stalking season runs from October through to end February.
